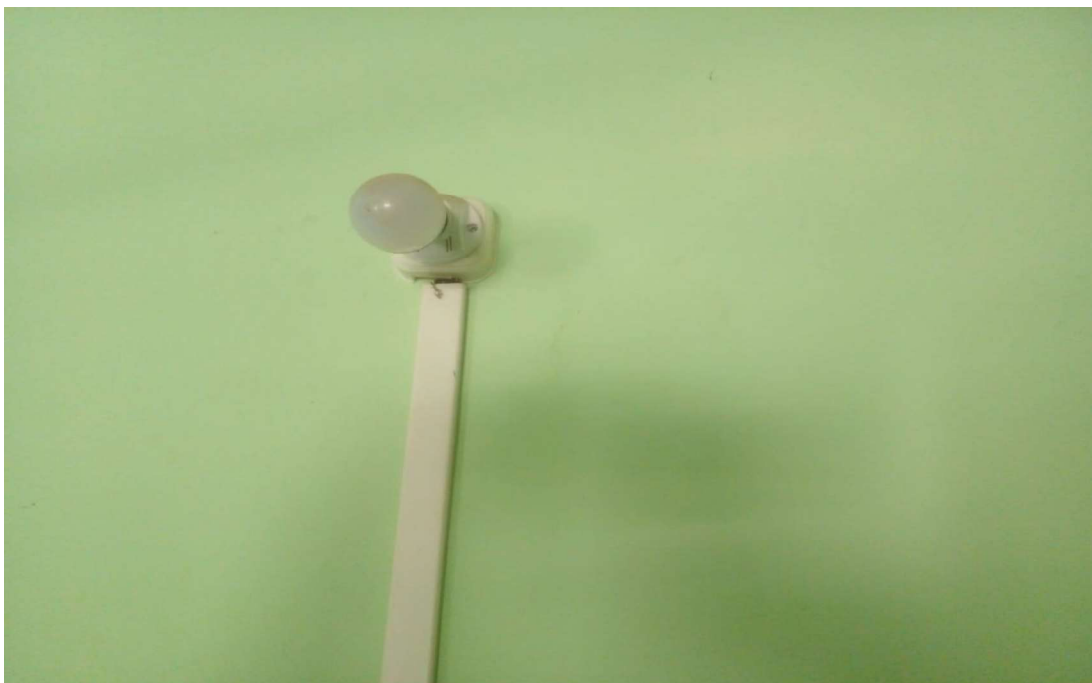

Solid waste management in our college

Bio-Degradation of solid Waste:



The waste generated in our college includes fruit and vegetable peels from the canteen, as well as fallen leaves and branches from plants. Once this waste is converted into raw material for composting, it can be degraded using common methods such as composting in pits, storing in bins, and vermicomposting. For non-biodegradable solid waste, which includes materials that cannot be decomposed by natural or biological processes like plastic, glass, and metals, recycling is one of the best and most popular management methods. Waste such as plastic, paper, and glass is collected in bins and generally given to waste collectors free of charge.
