This is to notify that the admission fee for B.A. 1st year under (FYUGP) is fixed as follows:

Rate of fees:-

1. Under Fee Waiver Scheme: 500/-

2. Without Fee Waiver Scheme: 6980/-

Categories of students eligible for Fee Waiver Scheme:

1. (a) Students whose parental income is less than 2 lakhs.

(b) If either of the parent of the student is in any Govt. service are not eligible for Fee Waiver Scheme.

2. (a) Income Certificate from local Revenue Circle Officer.

Or.

(b) The Head of the institution, from where a student has passed out, may also issue an Income Certificate for the purpose of Fee Waiver Scheme.

Or.

- (c) The student or his/her parents may submit a Notary Affidavit, in respect of his / her annual income for availing the Fee Waiver Scheme.
- 3. Students seeking admission in 1st year should plant a sapling at his/her college or at his/her home and shall give photograph of the same to the college at the time of admission. The student has to nurse the sapling and while seeking admission in Second year shall give photograph of the same tree that was planted in the previous year.

N.B-

- 1. All students are asked to submit their online generated hard copy of admission form at the time of admission.
- 2. All students are asked to produce their original documents at the time of admission.
- 3. The admission committee/scrutiny committee will examine all the documents of the students. The committee has the power either to accept or to reject the admission of any student.
