According to the UGC guidelines, the College has formed College Student Grievance & Redressal Cell, IQAC. The committee is formed with an objective to provide opportunities for redressal of grievances of students.

Procedure for redressal of grievances is stated in UGC regulations.

Accordingly, the College has formed Student Grievance Redressal mechanism as follows:

- 1. In case of any grievance an aggrieved student shall first submit his/her complain in writing to his/her concerndepartment. Department shall resolve the grievance within a week. In case the department is unable to resolve the grievance, the department shall forward it to the Grievance and redssal Cell of the college along with a comment.
- 2. A student may also raise his/her grievance directly in Grievance an Redressal Cell Of the college.
- 3. The Student Grievance Redressal Committee shall conduct a meeting Within stipulated time.
- 4. The committees shall discuss the issue and try to resolve it. The Committee shall take suitable measures to address the grievances at the earliest.
- 5. If a student is not satisfied with the decision of the Grievance and Redressal Cell he/she can appeal against the decision to the principal of the college.
